

MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE ON RULES, CALENDAR
AND OPERATIONS OF THE HOUSE

May 30, 2007

The Committee on Rules, Calendar and Operations of the House met on May 30, 2007 at 12:30 p.m. in Room 421 of the Legislative Office Building. The following members were present: Representatives Owens, Chairman; Hill, Vice Chairman; Luebke, Vice Chairman; Ross, Vice Chairman; Bell, Blue, Brubaker, Clary, Cole, Crawford, Holliman, Howard, Insko, Jeffus, Justice, Justus, Love, McComas, Pate, Steen, Weiss and Yongue.

The following bills and resolutions were considered:

PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL 86 –AN ACT TO DIRECT THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO STUDY MUNICIPAL ANNEXATION. Representative Cole moved that the proposed committee substitute be adopted, and the motion passed. Representatives Thomas and Goforth, principal sponsors, were recognized and spoke briefly on the bill. Representative Ross made a motion that the proposed committee substitute be given a favorable report, unfavorable to the original bill. The motion carried.

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 1425 –A JOINT RESOLUTION HONORING THE LIFE AND MEMORY OF WILMA DYKEMAN, ONE OF THE MOST INFLUENTIAL CONTRIBUTORS TO APPALACHIAN LITERATURE. Representative Ross was recognized to speak on the resolution. Representative Yongue moved for a favorable report, and the motion carried.

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 1860 – A JOINT RESOLUTION HONORING THE LIFE AND MEMORY OF REVEREND WILLIAM WALLACE "W.W." FINLATOR, SR., DISTINGUISHED SOUTHERN BAPTIST MINISTER AND PASTOR EMERITUS OF PULLEN MEMORIAL BAPTIST CHURCH. Representative Ross, a primary sponsor, was recognized to speak on the resolution. Representative Weiss moved for a favorable report, and the motion carried.

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 1986 – A JOINT RESOLUTION HONORING THE LIFE AND MEMORY OF SERGEANT HOWARD JOSEPH FLOUFF II, FALLEN WINSTON-SALEM POLICE OFFICER. Representative Folwell, sponsor, was recognized to speak on the resolution. Representative Howard moved for a favorable report, and the motion carried.

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 1929 -HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF RECOVERING THE REMAINS OF LANCE CORPORAL JOSEPH NELSON HARGROVE FROM THE ISLAND OF KOH TANG, CAMBODIA. Representative Tucker, sponsor, was recognized to speak on the resolution. Representative Luebke moved for a favorable report, and the motion carried.

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 1720 – A JOINT RESOLUTION HONORING THE MEMBERS OF THE NORTH CAROLINA NATIONAL GUARD AND THEIR FAMILIES FOR THEIR SERVICE TO THE STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA AND TO THE NATION SINCE
