Glossary

Several terms describe a municipality's influence over land inside and outside its borders and all have different shades of meaning.

Involuntary annexation

The process by which a municipality extends its limits to include property owners who have not requested municipal services. In North Carolina municipalities may initiate this process without permission from the county.

Urban service area

The area to which water and sewer service may ultimately be extended. In Wake County, each of the 12 municipalities has its own urban service area. Municipalities generally work out where the boundaries are.

Extraterritorial jurisdiction

For a municipality the size of Cary, an area extending not more than three miles beyond town limits in which the municipality may exercise planning and regulatory authority. This jurisdiction is granted by the county in which it is sought. Residents in this area do not receive town services such as water and sewer, public safety or garbage pickup, but also do not pay municipal property taxes.

City limits

The area where all city services are provided and which includes areas annexed once that process is final. Residents in this area pay municipal property taxes.
